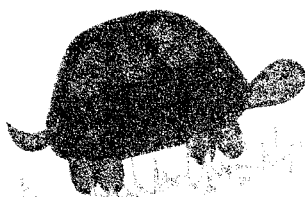

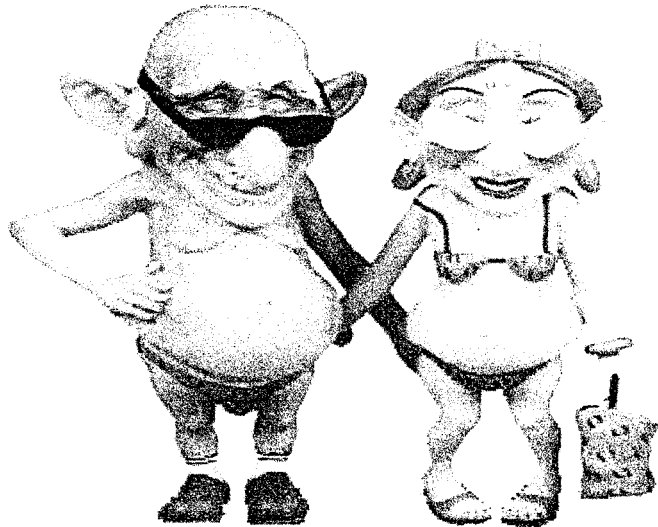
COMMUNITY SERVICE

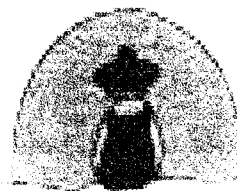
