## In Sea Isle, **Growth Slows**

SEA ISLE CITY — This city's construction office reported last week that the number of residential units in the city increased by 54 units during calendar year 2006.

That's a smaller increase the processor of 12,005

year 2000.
That's a smaller increase than occurred in 2005 – when the number of residential units increased by 107.
The total number of dwelling units in the city is now 7,104.
That's "still far below the 8,337 units allowable by the Cape May County Planning Board," according to the construction office.
During 2000, 30 single homes and 46 doubles or multiple units were demolished or moved. At the same time, new construction included 19 single homes and 60 double units. During 2005, 95 single homes and 31 doubles or multiple units were demolished or moved, and new construction included 27 singles and 104 doubles.
