Beach Tabs Not Free July 4 in SIC

SEA ISLE CITY — As part of its promotional campaign, the Sea Isle City Tourism Commission originated the "No Beach Tags on Wednesdays" program about 12 years ago. Part of the strategy was to encourage workers who work on weekends and get days off during the week to come to Sea Isle City on Wednesdays.

however, the loss of beach
tag revenues during the
popular 4th of July holiday
prompted city officials to
pass a resolution requiring

this year.

"This restriction applies only to 4th of July," explained Pat Allen, director of the beach badge office. She has posted notices of this change and asked beach tag inspectors to pass the word to visitors who often come to enjoy the beach on Wednesdays and to residents who frequently invite company on Wednesdays.
