

Who is the North End Association?

The North End Association, under the leadership of Irene Jameson, is an organization of homeowners from 1st Street through 30th Street in Sea Isle City. This group was formed in 1988 and has 130 members. Recently, a subgroup of members was formed to assist Dr. Jameson in promoting causes important to all owners and residents of Sea Isle City. This subgroup is known as NEWT – the North End Working Team.

The areas of concern North is currently working on are:

- 1) Alternate use for abandoned Landfill area at Fifth Street
- 2) Extension of sewers and securing FEMA community discount for all of Sea Isle City (See SICTA Newsletter of Aug 2006)
- 3) Beach Replenishment, especially Great Egg Harbor-Townsend Inlet Army Corps of Engineers Project (see SICTA Website for Water Resources Development Act article and ACE slides)
- 4) Reduction of Speed Limit in North End during Summer season
