OUR COMISSIONERS HAVE SAID:

- "Sea Isle City enjoys the third lowest tax rate in the county, behind Avalon and Stone Harbor"
- The new form of government will cost too much and estimate it could cost up to \$475,000 more per year

REFERENDUM SUPPORTERS RESPOND:

- Avalon and Stone Harbor, with the Mayor/Council Form of Government, have even lower tax rates
- Avalon and Stone Harbor also have lower total administrative costs than Sea Isle City
- The 2006 Budget documents for the three cities show the facts:
