WHEREAS, the Education, Budgets and Appropriations Law, N.J.S.A. 18a:22-37, requires the Governing Body of the City of Sea Isle City, after consultation with the City of Sea Isle City Board of Education, to determine the amount which is necessary to be appropriated in such budget and to certify to the County Board of Taxation the total amount so determined; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Sea Isle City has consulted with representatives of the Sea Isle City Board of Education, and has thereafter determined the amount necessary to be appropriated.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Sea Isle City, County of Cape May, State of New Jersey; that the following determination is hereby made:
