

## SICTA Alert – August 28, 2007

Beach Replenishment / Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) On August 1st, the House passed the final WRDA bill including \$135 million authorization for our beach replenishment (Great Egg Harbor–Townsend's Inlet project). Progress has been amazing, but there is still a great deal of work left before sand hits our beaches.

- The Senate needs to pass the final WRDA bill.
- The President must then sign the WRDA bill.
- WRDA only authorizes our project, but we need to keep up the pressure to be at the head of the line when funds are actually appropriated.

The Senate is scheduled to pass the final WRDA bill after their Labor Day return. But the President has threatened to veto this bill. Please consider contacting our:
