<u>Beesley's Point Bridge</u> Please help make the New Jersey Legislature realize how important this bridge is to Cape May County residents and visitors. Here's the issue:

The Beesley's Point Bridge which connects Cape May County to Atlantic County via US 9 has been closed for 3 years. This is one of only a few evacuation routes available to the people of Cape May County in the event of an emergency. The north-bound tollbooths on the Garden State Parkway create a bottleneck with normal summer traffic. It is estimated that it would take more than 30 hours to evacuate Cape May County in the event of a hurricane during the summer tourist season. It is critical that we reopen this important evacuation route. We urge the legislature to repair or replace the Beesley's Point Bridge.
