Successful Meeting

- June 5 TW/TP public meeting was considered by many to be the most successful ever.
- Success was due to 2 key factors:
 - Strong policy leadership by the Mayor on the need for a Quality of Life Squad and a determination to get noise & disorderly conduct under control.
 - Outstanding statistics & procedures outlined by the police department.
- Police Chief Kennedy plus 3 members of his command staff & 2 noise squad officers participated.
- Over Memorial Weekend 28 noise tickets were issued.
- Weekend of June 1, 2 & 3 produced 15 noise tickets.
- 3 problem houses were identified and will receive special surveillance.
- A suggestion to park a trash truck at Landis & 70th St. to be used as a drop off point will be evaluated.
- A proposal was put forth by a member to have our new council introduce an ordinance that would stop home deliveries of alcohol at 11:00 p.m. Unanimous support was expressed by those attending.
