

Keep Sea Isle City Clean Campaign Set

SEA ISLE CITY — Sea Isle City's public works department is asking property owners to join in a "Keep Sea Isle City Clean" campaign.

Bob McKeefery, assistant superintendent reminds residents that trash containers must have a lid and that it is a violation subject to a fine to place trash curbside before 6 p.m. the night before scheduled trash pick up.

"High winds and flooding make a real mess of a neighborhood. Be consider-

ate of your neighbors," said McKeefery.

Winter pick up schedule is as follows:

First to 44th Street, Wednesday for trash, and first Thursday of the month for bulk.

Forty-fifth to 70th Street, Monday for trash, and second Thursday of the month for bulk.

Seventy-first to 94th Street, Tuesday for trash and third Thursday of the month for bulk.

Bulk items such as a furniture and appliances

in good condition can be donated to charitable organizations such as Company of Angels, 856-691-6151 or Habitat for Humanity, 856-563-0292.

New to recycling is rigid plastics. They can be placed curbside on scheduled bulk days and include items such as plastic lawn furniture, pet cages, laundry baskets, coolers, etc.
