

County Library Offers Online Library Cards

COURT HOUSE — The Cape May County Library now offers property owners and permanent residents of Cape May County, with the exception of Ocean City and Avalon residents, the opportunity to acquire a Cape May County Library Card online at no charge.

To get your library card online, go to www.jerseyclicks.org and click on "Need a Library Card" selection.

You will be asked to enter your street address, zip code, and county. The form is sent electronically to the county library system where a temporary library card number is assigned that will be good for 14 days to use on JerseyClicks and Q&Anj.

You will receive your

official Cape May County Library Card along with a brochure regarding what the library offers shortly thereafter. To ensure accurate residency information, identification will be required at the time of checking out books and other materials for the first time.
