

Candidates Abound For Sea Isle Election

SEA ISLE CITY — As of the March 15 filing deadline, there were three mayoral and 20 council candidates vying for spots in the new form of government in the May 8 election.

To run for one of the six slots, mayor and five council seats, candidates needed 25 signatures on a petition.

The three mayoral candidates are Mayor Leonard Desiderio as well as George "Pat" Haffert and Donald Laricks.
