2007-08 Budget Guidelines

Budget Calendar

- By Wednesday February 21st Software download, including spreadsheets to calculate
- "adjustments"
- February 23rd Budget roll out at Stockton
- March 1st State aid available
- March 13th Budgets due in County Office
- March 26th-29th Public Hearings
- March 31st Question(s) due to County Clerk
- April 17th Annual school election

What remains the same for the 07-08 Budget?

- There is still a vote on the budget
- There are still separate questions
- The budget defeat process is the same
 - Budgets must be approved by the County Superintendent before advertising
- There are still adjustments to increase the Tax Levy

Tax Levy Cap Adjustments

Existing Adjustments

- Increases in Special Ed. costs over \$40,000
- Increase in Capital Outlay
- Incremental increases for opening a new school

New/Changes in Adjustments

Automatic Adjustments

- Health care increases over 4%. An excel spreadsheet will be provided
- Reduction in total formula aid over current year
- Enrollment This is part of the Tax Levy Cap Adjustment report

Commissioner Adjustments

- Special Education cost over \$40,000 Same form as last year
- Increase in Capital Outlay Same form as last year
- Opening a new school Same as last year
- Increase in tuition an excel spreadsheet will be used. This year it includes Vo-Tech.

Note: A new spreadsheet will be used to calculate the adjustments to determine the new Tax Levy amount. Accounts are restricted during the year. **Banked Cap is no longer available.**

Separate Proposals

Same process applies

- Cannot include programs that are T&E
- Include interpretive statement
- Defeated proposals submitted to Municipality for possible restoration if defeated
- If defeated and not restored, can only appeal to Municipality
- District must achieve all administrative efficiencies.

Exception: If the district wants the separate question to be built into the subsequent budget, must include the following:

"Clear statement on whether approval will affect only the current year or result in a permanent increase in the Levy"

For 2008-09

- Separate proposals will need 60% to pass
- If defeated, there is no appeal
- Commissioner adjustments will be replaced by waivers

Other provisions under A1

- Maximum surplus increased to \$250,000 or 2%
- New Emergency Reserve
 - * For current expense during the year
 - * Requires Commissioner approval to withdraw
 - * May budget into reserve for 07-08
 - * Beginning May 2008 but prior to June 30, can transfer line items into Capital or Maintenance reserves
 - * Requisite 50/50 split of anticipated excess surplus for appropriations into capital reserve is no longer applicable.
